Located at a steep slope at mid-level, the 200m tall residential tower and its curvilinear building shape commands an unparalleled view of the Victoria Harbour. This luxury residential development has 58 duplexes each over 3200 sq. ft. The building sits on a six storey podium encompassing multi-level car parking, the landscape garden and the club house.

Grade 65 high strength concrete has been used in the design together high strength steel reinforcing bars. A two storey jump form was used in the construction. To minimize wind induced movement, a multi-level damper tank was built into the top levels of the building absorb wind loads.
